Entries/Fees: \$15 Grounds fee per horse to offset arena rental and insurance costs. \$10 per Class before closing date, after closing date \$13 per class. You may enter more than once in the same class for schooling, but only one may be judged- you must declare which will be judged with ring steward before starting the round. Classes split into Junior (under 18) and senior (18 and over) if 6 entries or more in a class. Please make Checks payable to the "Wasatch Sport Horses". Refunds before closing date, in full, after closing entries may be applied to another show in the series or refunded, minus \$15 grounds fee. **Times:**

Approximate ride times will be sent via email 3-4 days prior to the event. Post entries will be accepted if space allows, and put at the end of each class order. **Awards:** Chocolate prize and more for 1st place!! Carrots and other goodies for 2nd thru 4th place.

Series Awards: Year-end Winter Jumper Series Champion and Reserve Champion awarded to the same horse/rider combination for the series- Low jumper, Mid Jumper and High Jumper divisions. Each Rider/horse combination may only win one division championship or reserve championship per year. If qualified in 2 divisions we will take the highest division's scores for year-end point tabulating. Points are as follows: 1st 50, 2nd 25, 3rd 15, 4th 10. You do not need to enter every class of division! We will use the largest two of the three division class scores for each division to tabulate our year-end awards, or one score if that is all you have entered for that division. Must compete in 3 of the 5 of the series shows in one division to be eligible for a year-end award in that division. **Warmups:** There will be a one-hour open warm up time prior to the show. You may lunge outside if weather allows- Max one horse at a time lunging in the indoor arena during open warm up time- 10 min max per horse.

. Also please note that at that time we will be setting up the jumping course as well! There will be a small indoor warm-up area with a XRail and small vertical fence. Approximate show ride times/warm up times will be given between each division to avoid congestion in the warm-up area. Standing horses must be in the indoor holding area or held/tied outside. **Attire:** Clinic attire. Riding helmet and riding boots or paddock boots with half chaps a must. **Show conduct and info:** No dogs allowed on the grounds according with Birt Arena policies. Management reserves the right to excuse any competitor, trainer or spectator for unsportsmanlike behavior. **Concessions:** There will be hot/cold drinks and food on sale. **Directions to Birt Arena:** From I-84: Take Nampa exit 38 (Garrity Blvd/Idaho Center exit). Turn south from off-ramp. Stay in left lane for a left turn (east) at the second stop light-Flamingo Ave. Take a right turn on to Happy Valley Rd. and go approximately 5 miles. Turn right onto Lewis Lane. Go approximately 1.4 miles to Hestehaven Lane (after Southside Blvd, before the NY Canal). Turn right on Hestehaven and follow the dirt road into parking lot. Ignore the "Private / No Trespassing" sign when entering.

Class format: Time is based on Meters per minute. All classes will be judged as a **USEF Table IV, Sec 1 Optimum time first round:** "The first round is decided by adding the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an "Optimum time", defined as 4 seconds less than the time allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this optimum time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest, etc"

RELEASE OF LIABILITY
For the North Wind Winter Jumping Series

Please read carefully:

I understand that horse activities, including shows, are high-risk sports and involve inherently dangerous risks of serious injury or death. I am participating in this horse show at my own risk. In consideration of the organization of this show, I hereby assume this risk, and further do hereby on behalf of myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns: (1) release and hold harmless the organizer, organizing committee, the IDEA, volunteers, judges, officials, and Birt Arena (collectively referred to as "Releasees") from any and all liability for actor or omissions resulting in accidents, damage, death, injury, or illness to myself and to my property, including the horse or horses which I will compete at this horse show; and (2) indemnify the Releasees from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of my actions, or the actions of my horse, during this event.

Warning: Under Idaho law, an equine activity sponsor is not liable for injury to or death of a participant or equine engaged in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. No participant or participant's representative may maintain an action against or recover from an equine activity sponsor or an equine professional for injury to or the death of a participant or equine engaged in an equine activity or resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. See Equine Immunity Act, I.C. § 6-1801, *et seq.*

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Idaho. This Release of Liability shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver of liability to the maximum extent permissible under law.
